

Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator City of Blue Earth Minnesota

The City of Blue Earth (pop.3321) is seeking applicants for the position of Wastewater Operator in a Class A activated sludge facility. This employee performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled technical work in the operation and maintenance of a municipal wastewater treatment plant and collection system. This position participates in snow removal and occasionally assists in other areas of the City Public Works Department. The position requires rotation of on-call and weekend duties and will be expected to work overtime as required. Applications are available at City Hall, 125 West 6th, Street from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday or phone 507-526-7336 and are **due Friday, June 8, 2018 at 5:00 P.M.**

The selected applicant will be required to obtain a Class D Wastewater Operators License and a type 4 Biosolids Certificate within 2 years. The successful applicant will also hold, or acquire within six months of hire, a Minnesota Class B CDL. Strong mechanical skills are highly desirable. Must be trainable in the various operations of a wastewater plant such as minor laboratory testing, troubleshooting equipment, plant control and efficiency as well as operating ag and light industrial equipment.

Applicants considered for hire will be required to pass a pre-employment drug screening and the successful applicant may be subject to on-going drug and alcohol testing.
