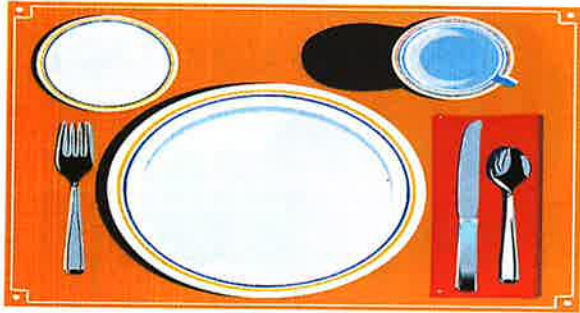

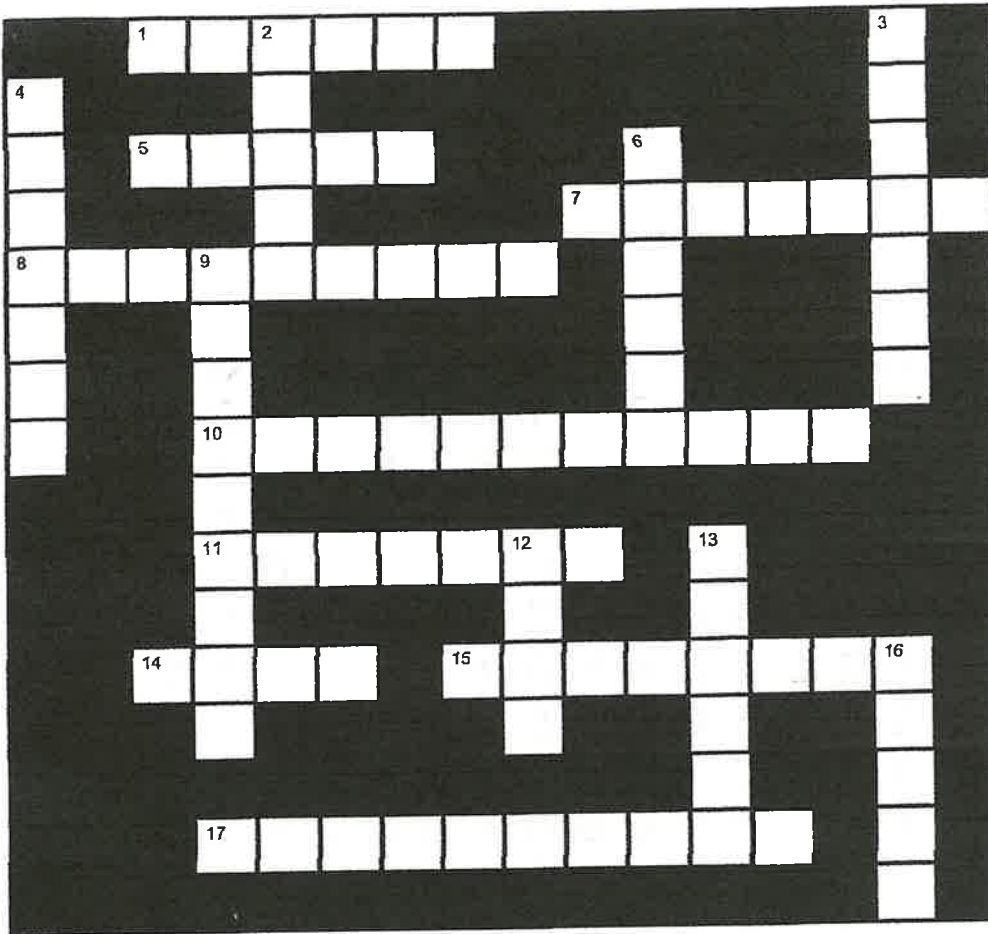


POTATO AND SOUP BAR FUNDRAISER
